Camp Nashoba provides equal opportunities to employees and applicants without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability or veteran status. All statements become part of any future employee personnel files. Completion of this application form does not require Camp Nashoba Day, Inc. to offer employment for any part of the season. The camp encourages people of any ethnic or national origin, color, religion, sex, age or disability to apply to the Camp. No question on this application is intended to secure information to be used for discrimination. Camp Nashoba Day is required by Massachusetts law to submit a CORI (Criminal Offender Record Information with Juvenile report) and SORI (Sex Offender Registry Information) on each staff person. The CORI regulations require that each applicant provide a government issued photo identification such as a driver's license, passport, state identification, etc... and that a copy of the id be kept on file with the camp.

Part of the camping experience involves activities and group interactions that may be new to staff members which may come with uncertainties beyond what is experienced at home. Such risks include uneven terrain, standing and moving water, forested and other areas that may result in wildlife encounters, including mammals, reptiles and insects including ticks and mosquitos that could result in infections and various insect transmitted diseases. I recognize that Camp Nashoba Day cannot guarantee that it is free from COVID-19, other pathogens and communicable diseases, and that as in any facility there is a risk of becoming ill. I am aware of these risks and I am assuming them on behalf of myself. I realize that no environment is risk-free, and so I understand the importance of abiding by the camp's rules, and I agree that I am familiar with these rules and will follow them. I agree to release Camp Nashoba Day from all claims resulting from the risks reasonably associated with camp activities.
